

The Journey of Lent

Originating in the fourth century of the church, the season of Lent spans 40 weekdays beginning on Ash Wednesday and climaxing on Holy Saturday.

There are many ways for a congregation to mark the journey of Lent. A visual reminder of the season is the Lenten Wreath of Thorns. On Ash Wednesday all candles are lit and then each Sunday during Lent one candle will be extinguished as the day of Jesus' crucifixion and death draws near. The wreath's growing darkness signifies the sacrifice our Lord made for each of us and focuses our personal and spiritual preparation during this season of Lent.

Many people give up something during Lent, but I like to ask people to take on something. Since we are in a pandemic, I would suggest you send someone a "thinking of your card", calling one of our homebound members, praying for those on our prayer list, or anything else you might want to take on.

Whatever you choose to do, may it be something that will enhance your personal and spiritual journey of Lent.

LENT 2021

The highlight of the year for Christians is Easter, the day when our Lord rose from the dead. Lent is a 40 day season of preparation for Easter.

We will begin the season of Lent with the **Shrove Tuesday TO GO Pancake supper on Tuesday February 16 from 5:00 to 6:30 p.m.** (See article **elsewhere in newsletter**) Shrove Tuesday is also called "Fat Tuesday" because on that day a thrifty housewife uses up the fats that she has kept around for cooking, but that she will not use during Lent. Since pancakes are a standard way of using up fat, that is why we have a pancake meal.

As of this writing, it appears we will NOT be doing Ashes to Go. If something should change we will let you know.

Our first Lenten service begins on Ash Wednesday at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday February 17th. (As of the writing of this article, we don't know if we will have in person service or not.) All candles on the Lenten Wreath will be lit at this service, and beginning on the First Sunday of Lent, one will be extinguished each week, with the final candle extinguished on Good Friday.

St. John's Episcopal Church Vestry Meeting December 2020

Present: Verlyn Bolinger, Karla Cox, Martha Stone, Dennis Condon, Jupe Allen and Mother Sharon. Development: Gospel Based Disciples included and reading from Luke 22:39-53 Treasurer's Report: The transaction and budget reports were reviewed. After reaching out to a few parishioners, we

are now only \$1679 behind with pledges. We currently have 8 pledge commitments for 2021 for \$37,900 and more are expected. The report was approved. **Old Business:** Splash Pad donations totaled \$222. The church will match and send a check for \$444. Candy Scarborough has accepted the position of Lay Person to the SE Minster committee. The Thanksgiving Dinner was a success serving an estimated 110 people. The Nominating Committee has submitted a list of 3 candidates for the two Vestry positions to be vacant: Candy Scarborough, Bess Stone-Bolinger and Carrie Tierney. Candidates for delegate and alternate to Convocation and Convention are Verlyn Bolinger and Martha Stone. They are unopposed. Tommy McLarty is running unopposed for Endowment Board. The search for additional parishioners to operate the camera and music box is suspended for now due to the closing of the church due to the pandemic. New Business: Our old copier in the church office is on its last leg with another breakdown and no parts available for repair. A gently used replacement is available from McCarty's Office Products. It is a Canon and costs \$2,100. Funding will be planned in next years budget. Mother Sharon, after some deliberation, mostly concerning her health, has signed a letter of agreement extending her tenure as St John's Vicar for another year. The agreement contains provisions for her to take more Sundays off throughout the year. Bishop Bascom has issued a directive that with the exception of Christmas Eve, no in person services be held until Epiphany, January 6, 2021. From Epiphany to Palm Sunday the metrics on the Diocesan website must be followed using local Covid-19 infection numbers to determine if we are allowed to have in person services. As before, the possibility exists in-person services will once again be suspended.

One service for Christmas Eve will be held at 7:00 pm. Parishioners will be notified and asked if attending. If more than 25 respond favorably a second service at 8:30 will be scheduled.

A sizable donation to the Snack-Pack program was received in the amount of \$500. The

Outreach committee will send a thank you card. Assessment:

Minutes from the November 9 meeting were approved.

Vicar's Report: The Vicar has completed the required training and background check to be able to continue serving the church. Wardens:

decorating the Jesse Tree via Zoom.

Adult: Since there will be no Advent study, inserts on the Way of Love campaign are

being placed in the weekly E-blast.

Stewardship: A Tree of Life charm will be ordered and presented to those who make a pledge

to the church.

Planned Giving: No report.

Buildings & Grounds: No report.

Endowment: \$119,924.22 is the balance on

November 30.

ECW: No report.
